



She asks them about their lives, work, and families. She helps people with difficulties. She also helps people find classes and programs they need.

When work is over, Rebecca goes home and listens to music. "We always have music playing in our house," she says. She loves making dinner while listening to music. She likes songs about love, travel, and adventure. Later in the evenings, she plays the piano or the guitar. Sometimes she practices some old songs. Sometimes she writes new ones. "I always make time for the things I love," she says.

Rebecca lives with her American husband, Jeremy, and their three-year-old son, Ben. "I first met Jeremy at a folk music club. I was singing an old country song from America.
